2. PURPOSE


Purpose of this document is to describe the Symabook application usage. Symabook is a S60 Facebook application, which enables user to access Facebook stream, interact with friends, and update the status from S60 mobile phones. Symabook features a user interface never seen before on S60 phones. It is sleek, novel and highly usable, functionality that is particularly beneficial when viewing photos.

3. PRECONDITION

It's recommended to have a working Facebook account available, but it's not mandatory. A Facebook profile can be registered via S60 browser when starting the Symabook.

Symabook works with devices described in the *Working configuration* chapter with an internet connection available.

4. WORKING CONFIGURATION

Symabook application is supported by S60 3rd and 5th Edition platforms.

Application is formally tested to be compatible with the following S60 platform releases and devices,

1. S60 3rd Edition (Nokia E65)
2. S60 3rd Feature Pack 1 (Nokia N95)
3. S60 3rd Feature Pack 2 (Nokia E75)
4. S60 5th Edition (Nokia N97).

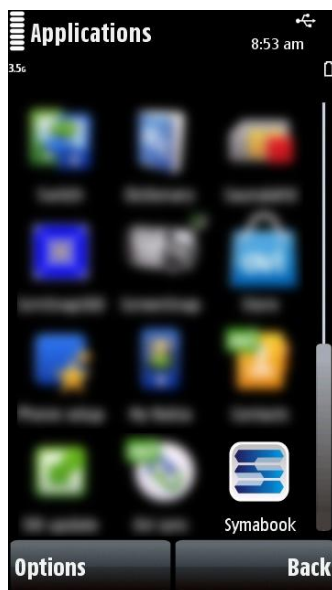
Device support is not limited to models above.

5. SETUP

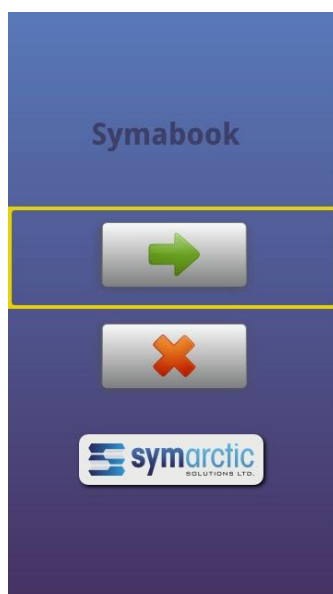
Follow next steps when installing Symabook.

1. After installing the Symabook.sis (or equivalent), start the application from the S60 application grid.



In order to work Symabook installer installs also the external components: PIPS, Signal Server and Symbian OS Pipes if not available already on the device.


2. Login page opens, press the green arrow button.



Pressing **green** arrow start the Facebook login procedure.

Pressing **red** arrow end the application.

After pressing the green button, select the appropriate internet access point.

3. Fill in the Facebook account details



The S60 browser is opened to Facebook page.



Fill in the Email and Password fields.

You can select also the "Keep me logged in to Symabook" for convenience

Press Login to proceed.


Click Yes to questions asked by the S60 browser.

4. After the Facebook login procedure is ok, you are told to close the browser window and return to the Symabook application.

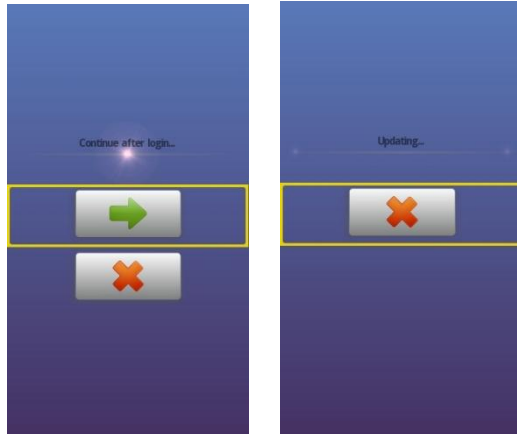


You may now close this window and return to the application.

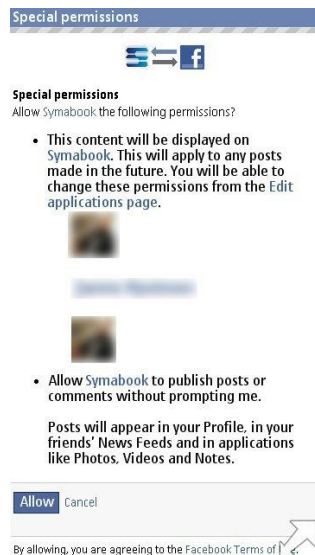
In Symabook, press the **green** arrow to proceed and you will see Symabook to start updating your profile. After the first time setup, the updating time depends on your internet connection speed and the Facebook responsiveness.




5. Special permission

In the first time using Symabook, the Facebook acquires special permission for the application to be able to communicate with Facebook.

After completing stage 4, the S60 browser opens to Facebook page asking the Special permissions.



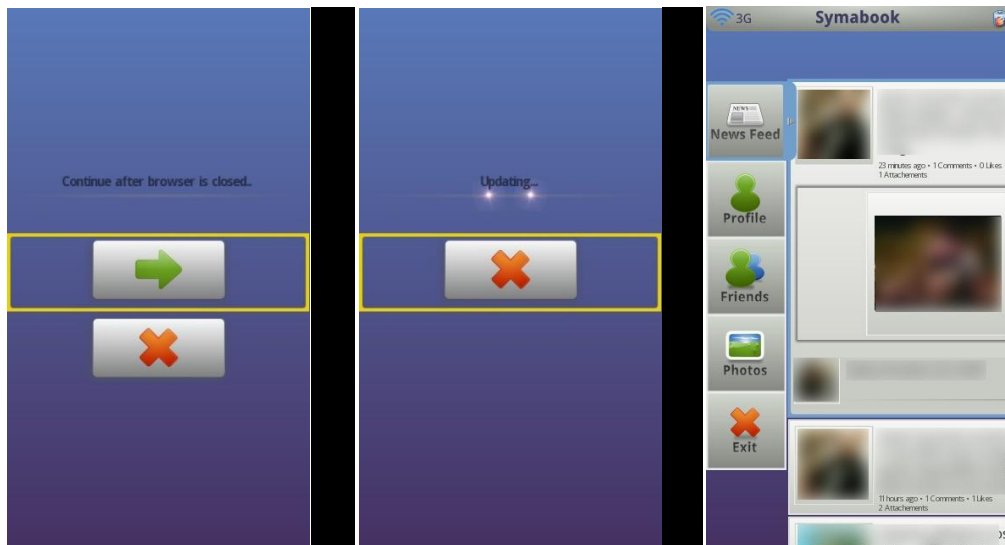
Press **“Allow”** to give permissions to Symabook.

6. One more **green** arrow click in Symabook and your Facebook information is updated and Symabook is ready to be used.



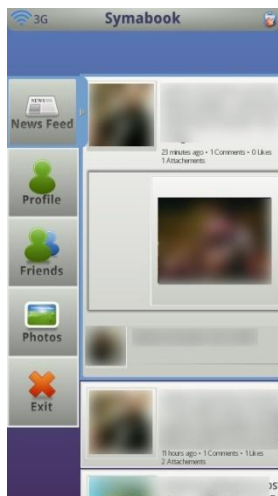
Setup is completed and Symabook is ready to be used.

6. FEATURES

Symabook features are ease to use. All the main features are in the left side of the device screen. In touch screen the main features become visible by sliding pen or finger from left to right. Similarly varying options become visible sliding finger from right to left. In traditional keyboard devices, one can navigate with the navigation key.

News feed

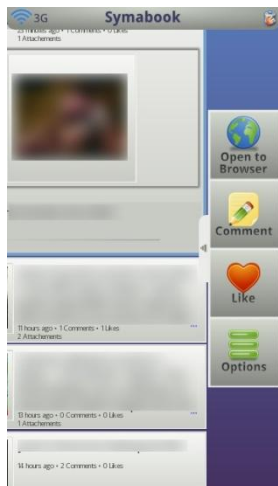


In the News feed one can see the comments and status changes of the Facebook friends.


A news feed items can be browsed by sliding finger up and down or with the navigation key.

An item for closer look can be opened by tapping (touch screen devices) or selecting the wanted item, which opens the item related comments.

It is possible to take actions (e.g. Comment, Like) to News feed item.



It is possible to take actions such as Comment or Like to News feed item by tapping it or selecting the wanted action and pressing the selection key.

Profile



The Profile main options show the users profile and enables him/her to update and clear the status, see the Facebook wall and see the albums

Friends

In Friends menu one can browse and see details of the Facebook friends as well as to look into Friends albums.

Photos

In photos it is possible to browse the photos into the device. One photo can be zoomed by clicking or tapping it. This also allows one to upload the photo to Facebook's album called Symabook. The uploaded photo can also be seen now in the Profile's Symabook album.

Exit


Shut down the Symabook by pressing Exit.

Options

In the right side of the screen application options are available as well as the dynamic menu.

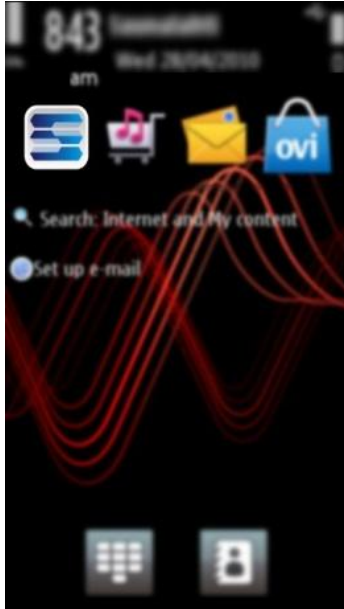


Options let user for instance to see Help and About dialogs and to logout from the Facebook account.

7. TIPS AND TRICKS

Home screen shortcut




Shorten the time to access Symabook by inserting the Symabook to homescreen shortcut.

It's notable that homescreen is not supported in all devices.

Keep me logged in



For your convenience you may tap the "Keep me logged in to Symabook" when logging in to Facebook via S60 browser (see Setup) to keep the easy access to Symabook even shutting down the application for longer periods of time.

8. KNOWN ISSUES

Symabook depends heavily on the Facebook platform. In practice this means that if Facebook changes their platform or Facebook platform is not working fully, Symabook is not able to communicate fully or partially with Facebook.

The time to update the Facebook data depends on the speed of the network and relies on the responses from the Facebook servers. In

Device browser

Symabook relies on the S60 browser. The functionality of the browsers may vary between S60 releases, which may lead to "You are not logged in" error in first time login (See Setup).



Special Permissions
You must be logged in to Facebook to use this feature.Okay

In first time login special permissions are asked when logged in. One needs to be logged in, but in some S60 browsers the login information is lost when browser is closed.

Solution is to leave the browser opened in Setup stage 4, which let user to give permissions normally to Symabook.
